Purpose of LGBT Staff Network

We have formed the LGBT Staff Network to create a supportive working environment and policy framework for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender (LGBT) colleagues while also encouraging all staff within the trust to understand the needs of LGBT individuals within the community.

We aim to:

- to eliminate discrimination
- to influence policy making and monitor existing policies
- to provide a support function to colleagues
- to support the Trust with the training of staff at all levels
- highlight any health inequalities that influence service delivery
- to promote Trust services as a healthcare provider and employer within the local LGBT communities

About the LGBT Staff Network

Membership and Representation

The Network is open to all LGBT;

- employees
- volunteers
- temporary workers
- students

Engagement is also welcomed from other employees who are committed to the aims of the network and will also be open to colleagues who have a role in supporting the work environment for LGBT colleagues and experience of patients.

Network Meetings

The network will meet every 2 months and the locations will be moved around the geographical area of the trust to enable individuals to attend. Dial in facilities will be made available to individuals who cannot attend due to location.

Roles within the Network

- Chairperson
- Information Officer
- Social Officer

The election of people into the above roles will take place every six months.
