Clinical Practice


- To have responsibility, working alongside Dietetic colleagues and the MDT, for the provision

- To help improve outcomes for infants, children and young people with specialised nutritional needs
- To work as part of the MDT to ensure holistic patient care, this involves reviewing the patients with the MDT, and fully participating in the problem solving aspects of consultations
- To assess nutritional status of patients based on weight, height, BMI, weight history as well as biochemistry, diet history and other validated methods of nutritional assessment

Education

- Provide structured, individualised, effective and ongoing education to children, young people and their carers
- Education may be done in clinic, in group sessions, on home visits or by telephone
- To act as a resource for colleagues regarding nutritional management
- To provide structured, effective education to Healthcare professionals
- To develop teaching aids for educational purposes
- To continually monitor, develop and improve the service through audit, research, literature reviews and reflective practice

Communication

- To communicate effectively with children and young people and to demonstrate skills in negotiation, motivation, explanation
- To communicate effectively with carers, extended family members, schools and HCPs

Staff leadership


• Provide clinical leadership to band 3 Dietetic assistants working in the team, including joint setting of personal and team objectives, 1 to 1 meetings and PDRs
