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ABOUT THE TRUST

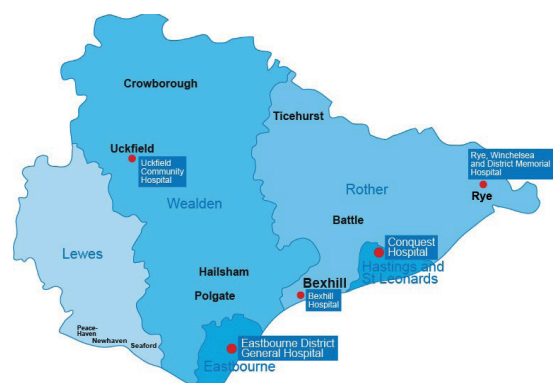
East Sussex Healthcare NHS Trust is an integrated acute and community health services provider, caring for over half a million residents as well as the visitors and tourists that visit our coastal county all year round. We are the lead provider of a wide range of hospital-based services across East Sussex as well as offering community led services across much of the same area.

Our services are mainly provided from two district general hospitals, the Conquest Hospital in Hastings and Eastbourne District General Hospital both of which have Emergency Departments and provide care 24 hours a day. They offer a comprehensive range of surgical, medical and maternity services supported by a full range of diagnostic and therapy services.

At Bexhill Hospital we provide outpatients, ophthalmology, rehabilitation and intermediate care services. At Rye, Winchelsea and District Memorial Hospital we provide Outpatient and inpatient intermediate care services. We also provide some services at Uckfield Community Hospital.

Our community teams also provide care in the patient's own home, over 100 community sites across East Sussex and GP surgeries. We employ over 7,500 people across the organisation and we have an annual income of over £550 million.

In 2020 the Care Quality Commission (CQC) rated us as 'Good' overall, and 'Outstanding' for being caring and effective. Conquest Hospital in Hastings and our community services were rated 'Outstanding' and Eastbourne DGH was rated 'Good'.



ABOUT THE CLINICAL RESEARCH TEAM

Clinical research is a key priority for the trust. We have delivered and supported research over the last 30 years within our hospitals and we have received awards and recognition of the work undertaken. The trust has been involved in a combination of multi-centre commercial and academic studies worldwide with leading pharmaceutical companies.

We have a very professional, pro-active approach to delivering new studies with our sponsors. The research team has delivered agreed recruitment within timelines and often exceeds recruitment targets. We pride ourselves with having a close relationship with our sponsors from first contact. Our research governance team are very experienced in working with sponsors and making this process efficient and effective.

Clinical research is a key priority for our trust. In collaboration with the Trust Board, the Research and Development department are actively expanding research capacity, promoting recruitment into commercial and academic clinical trials, whilst encouraging clinician's and AHP's to be involved in developing their own research. Research participation is imperative in improving the health outcomes and benefits to our patients. Involving healthcare professionals in the delivery of innovative treatments increases job satisfaction, staff retention, continuous learning, and evidenced-based care.

Last year...

- our emergency departments had 130,000 attendances

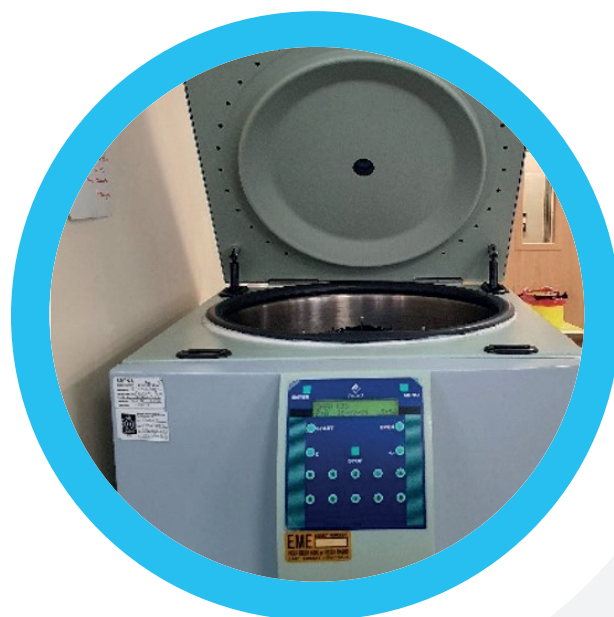

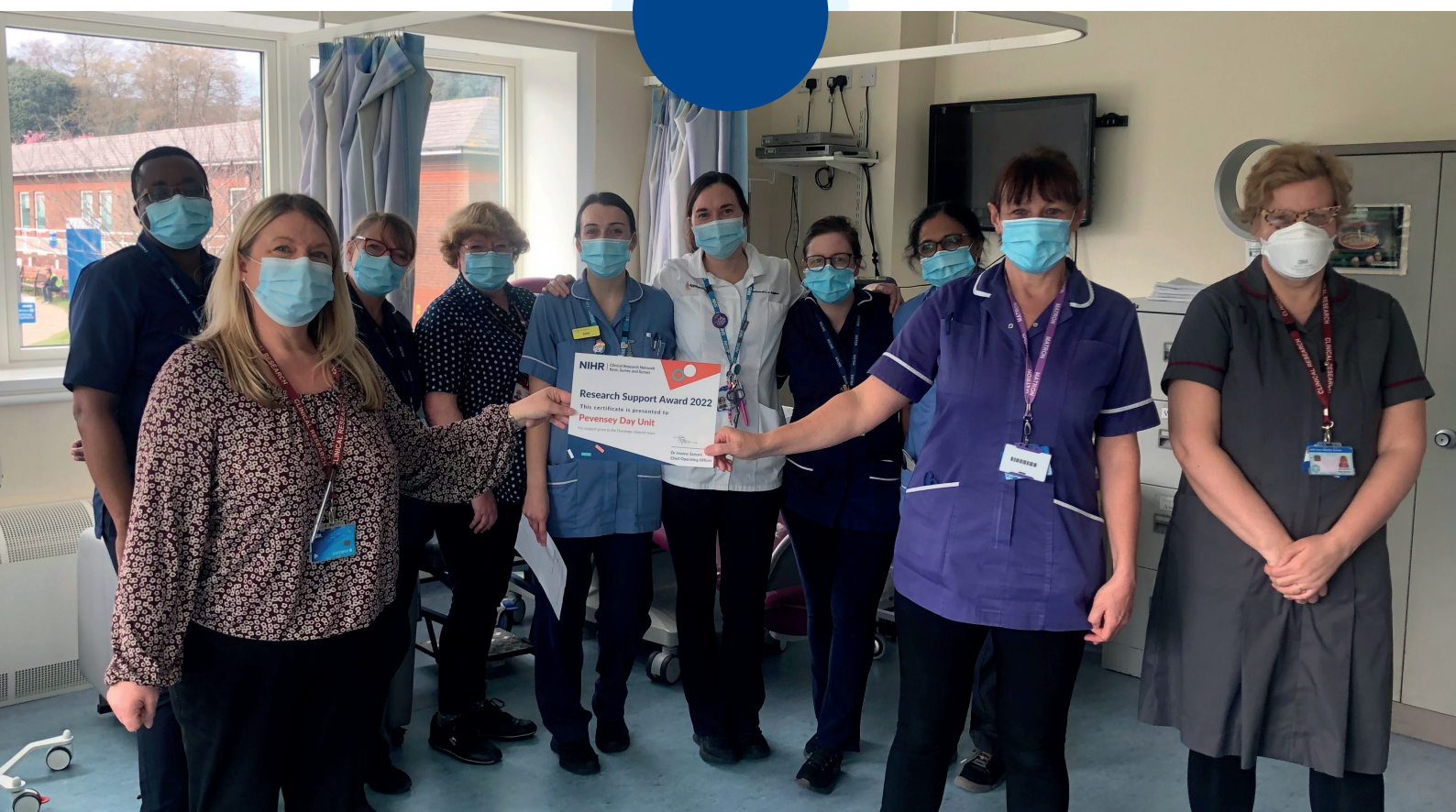
