We offer a basic salary of £22,383. Plus, for all hours you work between 8pm and 6am Monday – Friday and any time on Saturday, you'll get a shift bonus taking you to at least £16.15 per hour. For Sundays and Public Holidays you could be earning at least £20.96 per hour. Averaged over the year, this means your salary could be up to £24,621.
