University Hospitals Plymouth (UHP) NHS Trust is the largest hospital on the Southwest Peninsula providing comprehensive secondary and tertiary care to a population of around 2,000,000 people who can access our specialist services. We work closely with our community partners in delivering comprehensive health and social care.

UHP is the largest specialist teaching hospital in the south west peninsula working in partnership with University of Plymouth and Plymouth Marjon University.

From September 2024, the highly-ranked University of Bath MPharm degree will be available to study at the University of Plymouth. There will be opportunities for pharmacist colleagues to participate in these educational activities, with the potential for more formal roles with the University of Bath in the future.

The Women's and Children's Care Group was established in 2013 and is comprised of the following clinical service lines: Gynaecology and IVF, Genitourinary medicine and PAC, Maternity Services, Neonatology, Community and Specialist Paediatrics and has been rated 'Good by CQC'.

The Care Group offers a full range of services to meet the health care needs of women, including maternity care, care for the newborn, and both general and specialist gynaecological care. Our tertiary level neonatal service (Level 3) takes referrals for acutely ill and pre-term babies from Plymouth and across the rest of Devon and Cornwall. We also provide general and specialist paediatric services for children and young people, both on the main Derriford Hospital site and at the Child Development Centre. The paediatric service also includes a level 2 paediatric oncology share care with Bristol Royal Hospital for Children.

The Pharmacy team are considered an integral member of the multidisciplinary team, joining a team of clinicians, nurse specialists and other allied healthcare professionals providing a dedicated service to patients across the Peninsula.

In Plymouth we are undergoing an exciting transformation which is seeing the continuous development of career opportunities for the right candidate. As one of seven NHS Trusts nationally to be hosting the 'People First' pilot our team are continuously identifying innovative ways to improve their own practice and in doing so improving our patient's experience.
